PARISH REPORT 2022/23





Planning

- > Planning process in WCC/SNDP is still incredibly slow
- ▶ 26 planning applications processed in 2022/23, 15 without comment, 7 objections and 4 the Parish Council asked for more information.







The Parish Council have £2,000 this year to give to local groups

- > The Parish Council paid out £1,450.00 in Grants over the year to:
 - > OMCA £500 For new gazebos for the fete
 - ➤ Citizen Advice £250 To help local people
 - St Andrews Church £400 For grass cutting
 - ➤ Senior Club £200 To help towards travel costs for outings
 - ➤ Owslebury Newsletter To help towards printing costs

Sports Field



- > The Parish Council paid to have the burnt pavilion removed from the site.
- The Pavilion Committee arranged for a container to be placed at the site so the Mens 1st and 2nd Cricket Team can play at the ground this season.
- > The Sports Club kindly donated money towards the container.
- > The Committee organised a Sports afternoon for the Kings Coronation.
- The Committee are rethinking the design of the new pavilion in light of rising costs.
- The Committee are looking into a modular pavilion and are currently getting costings for this.
- > Once the costing are done they will be applying for grants towards the cost



Other



- > An Owslebury Climate Group has been established
- Christmas Lights were brilliant again our thanks to the team
- Passed our Financial Audit
- An affordable housing Survey was carried out in Owslebury
- > A New Notice board has been installed in the Glebe Field
- Beech Grove pathway improvement
 - The Full Design has been completed and is being uploaded into the Hampshire highways portal
 - Once this has been done the work can start
 - A grant has been applied for to pay for this improvement

- > We are in the process of designing a new website.
- > We have resurfaced the roundabout and installed a new basketball backboard and hoop.
- > The Council Reviewed 27 Policies and Risk Assessments
